Purpose of the role:

The Project Coordinator plays a key role in delivering The Foundation's provincial eye health program. The role coordinates implementation across partners and districts, ensures activities align with workplans and budgets, and supports provincial health offices in integrating eye care into local health systems.

Working closely with the Senior Program Manager, the position helps translate national and provincial priorities into effective local action—strengthening partnerships, improving coordination, and ensuring quality, inclusive eye health services for communities.

The Project Coordinator will own the outcomes of:

- Program Coordination and Implementation** - Leads the day-to-day coordination of provincial project activities, ensuring timely and quality delivery in line with agreed plans, budgets, and MoU commitments with the Ministry of Health and Provincial Health Offices.
- Partner Engagement and Capacity Strengthening** - Works closely with Provincial and District Health Offices, hospitals, and NGOs to support joint planning, training, and reporting. Builds local capacity in project management, financial compliance, and data quality.
- Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning** - Coordinates data collection and reporting using Power BI, Accelerator, and SharePoint. Tracks progress against indicators, supports review meetings, and promotes continuous learning across partners.
- Finance and Operations Support** - Collaborates with the Finance and Operations team to manage forecasts, procurement, and expenditure reporting, ensuring all activities comply with The Foundation's policies and donor requirements.
- Stakeholder Engagement and Communication** - Acts as a key liaison for provincial stakeholders, facilitating communication between partners, health offices, and The Foundation. Supports advocacy, visibility, and community engagement efforts to promote eye health.
- Health, Safety, and Safeguarding** - Ensures compliance with The Foundation's policies on safeguarding, health, safety, and inclusion, and models the organisation's values in all work and relationships.
- Other tasks as requested by your manager.
