

I was honoured to step into the role of CEO at The Fred Hollows Foundation — an organisation with a powerful legacy and unwavering commitment to restoring sight and ending avoidable blindness. I would like to acknowledge the deep loyalty of our supporters and reinforce my commitment to The Foundation's work to make a positive human impact. I am inspired by the legacy of Professor Fred Hollows, whose vision and passion continue to guide us.

In 2024, we celebrated major milestones: the World Health Organization declared Pakistan and Vietnam free of trachoma as a public health problem — the result of over a decade of dedicated work. In Nepal, we proudly opened the Nijgadh Tilganga Community Eye Hospital, set to treat up to 55,000 patients annually. These achievements are only possible because of your generosity. Together, we are turning Fred's vision into reality — a world where no one is needlessly blind or vision impaired.

Thank you for standing with us and making this life-changing work possible.



在過去 33 年間,護瞳行動已為來自 25 個國家的超過三百萬人恢復視力。儘管取得了令人鼓舞的成果,全球眼科健康仍面臨日益嚴峻的挑戰,包括人口老化、眼科人力短缺,以及體制性障礙。預計到 2050 年,全球將有約 17 億人受到視力喪失的影響,其中九成居住於中低收入國家。為了應對這些挑戰,護瞳行動推出了一項大膽的五年策略 (2024–2028),以實現長遠而可持續的改變。

Over the past 33 years, The Fred Hollows Foundation has restored sight to over three million people across 25 countries. Despite this progress, global eye health faces mounting challenges due to ageing populations, workforce shortages, and systemic barriers. By 2050, an estimated 1.7 billion people will experience vision loss, with 90% living in low-to-middle income countries. In response, The Foundation launched a bold five-year strategy (2024–2028) focused on sustainable impact.

Through sustainable solutions, The Foundation aims to transform lives and create lasting change — ensuring no one is needlessly blind or vision impaired.

在 2024 年,護瞳行動在保護視力和改變生命方面取得了重要進展。透過策略性夥伴合作、創新方案 及不懈倡議,我們積極推動眼健康被視為不僅僅是醫療需求,更是一項人權以及推動社會發展的重要 動力。以下重點展示了我們在三大核心目標上的成果與進展。

In 2024, The Fred Hollows Foundation made powerful strides in protecting sight and transforming lives. Through strategic partnerships, innovative solutions, and tireless advocacy, we advanced our mission to ensure eye health is recognised not just as a medical need — but as a human right and a driver of development. The following highlights showcase our progress across three key goals.

2024 年年底,位於尼泊爾的 Tilganga 社區眼科醫院正式啟用。醫院建於全國眼健康資源最匱乏的地區之一,逾一百萬名尼泊爾人正受視力損失困擾,而白內障更佔當地失明病例近 67%。新醫院的成立,為最需要幫助的人群帶來希望,特別是女性,她們受可避免失明影響的比例更高,現在將能更容易獲得適切的眼科護理服務。

多得護瞳行動與 Tilganga 眼科醫院的共同努力·這所新醫院將提供涵蓋十個次專科的先進治療·預計五年內服務約 274,000 名患者。醫院設有專業手術室、激光治療室及完善藥房·是希望的象徵·也是我們堅定不移恢復視力與尊嚴承諾的見證。

In late 2024, a dream became reality with the inauguration of the Nijgadh Tilganga Community Eye Hospital in Nepal's Madhesh Province — one of the country's most underserved regions for eye health. With

over one million Nepalis living with vision loss, and cataract accounting for nearly 67% of blindness, this new facility brings hope where it's needed most. Women, disproportionately affected by avoidable blindness, will now have better access to care.

Thanks to The Fred Hollows Foundation and its long-standing partner, the Tilganga Institute of Ophthalmology, the hospital will offer advanced treatment across 10 subspecialties, serving an estimated 274,000 patients over five years. Equipped with operating theatres, laser rooms, and a full-service pharmacy, it stands as a beacon of compassion and excellence.



2024 年 10 月,越南及巴基斯坦正式獲世界衞生組織認證,成功消除沙眼這一公共衞生問題,標誌著一項重大里程碑。沙眼是全球最常見的傳染性致盲疾病,曾經重創無數社區,尤以婦女及兒童受影響最深。過去十多年,護瞳行動與兩國政府緊密合作,深入偏遠地區,協助落實世界衞生組織的SAFE 策略。

於越南北部山區及巴基斯坦農村地帶,前線醫護人員克服包括新冠疫情在內的重重困難,將護理 與健康教育帶給有需要人士。

沙眼的消除,將為數以百萬計群眾帶來持久改變,重拾尊嚴、機遇與希望。這更是全國醫療體系各層面堅持不懈承諾的成果。

In October 2024, a major milestone was achieved — Vietnam and Pakistan were officially validated by the World Health Organization as having eliminated trachoma as a public health issue. Trachoma, the world's leading infectious cause of blindness, once devastated communities, especially mothers and children. For over a decade, The Fred Hollows Foundation worked hand-in-hand with both governments, reaching remote areas and supporting the implementation of the WHO's SAFE strategy.

In mountainous regions and rural heartlands, dedicated health workers overcame immense challenges — including the COVID-19 pandemic — to deliver care and education. The elimination of trachoma will have a lasting impact on millions — restoring dignity, opportunity, and hope. This is the result of unwavering commitment at every level of the health system.

2024 年,護瞳行動繼續積極倡導,將眼健康視為全球發展不可或缺的一環。良好的眼健康不僅改善整體健康,更促進教育及經濟成果。我們特別強調輔助技術 (如眼鏡) 的重要性,確保人人都接觸到眼健康服務。此外,我們亦致力推動性別平等,透過「醫療衞生界女性領袖培育計劃」提升來自東南亞的 15 位女性醫療領袖的能力,讓她們發揮更大影響力。

這一系列工作,正體現我們對釋放政策動力及資源的承諾,推動社會各界將眼健康視為不僅僅是醫療議題,更是一條邁向尊嚴、機會與平等的道路。護瞳行動將繼續與合作夥伴攜手,共同推動眼健康成為全球發展議程的優先目標,讓更多人受惠於光明未來。



In 2024, The Fred Hollows Foundation continued to champion eye health as a vital part of global development. Eye health uplifts broader health, education, and economic outcomes. We spotlighted the importance of assistive technologies like glasses, ensuring no one is left behind. We also addressed gender equity by empowering 15 women health leaders from Southeast Asia through the Women in Health Leadership Program.

These efforts reflect our commitment to unlocking political will and resources, ensuring eye health is recognised not just as a medical issue — but a pathway to dignity, opportunity, and equality.
